## SATELLITE INSTALLATION POLICY

The following policy applies to all residents of Dayton Housing Authority (including Summerview Heights)

- 1. Satellite dish may not exceed one meter in diameter (3 feet, 3 inches) measured across the widest part.
- 2. Satellite dish must be mounted on a metal pole and anchored properly. Dish may be installed only in your yard area as close to your apartment as possible. All cables must be buried in order to avoid a mowing or tripping hazard.
- 3. Dish must be installed in a secure manner so it will not fall or injure someone.
- 4. Satellite dish may not be mounted on exterior walls, window frames, roofs, or any other common area outside of your apartment.
- 5. Professional installation is required and a representative from Dayton Housing Authority's maintenance department must be present.
- 6. Residents are responsible for removal of satellite dish when vacating the apartment or discontinuing the satellite service. If the dish must be removed by Dayton Housing Authority the resident will be charged for the cost of removing the dish.
- 7. Resident agrees to indemnify and hold Dayton Housing Authority harmless from any and all liability from, in relation to or associated with the satellite dish and related equipment.
